## Meeting Notes Feb. 19th

Bond is proposed to be increased on the Garnet claim so that the mechanical area size can be increased. Plans to dig out the discharge pond are being made, and as a reminder to all members, make sure you are removing your tailings from any natural water where you are sluicing or panning.

This proposes a member staking a 20 foot area for the year as opposed to the 3 day buck marking rule. 
